

# Advancing Sustainability: PE and PP Mixed Structures Now Recyclable in the UK

OPRL (On-Pack Recycling Label), announces that Polyethylene (PE) and Polypropylene (PP) mixed structures are now officially recyclable in the United Kingdom. This achievement marks a pivotal moment in our commitment to providing sustainable packaging solutions.





# **OPRL Guidance Update**

**Effective January 2024,** OPRL updates its guidance to allow recycling of PE and PP mixed structures.

## **Key Criteria for Recyclability:**

- Minimum 90% mixed polyolefin content.
- Specific limits for other materials like EVOH.
- Metallisation allowed within specified parameters.
- Labels of different materials should be easily removable and limited in size.

### **Assurance for Customers:**

- Customers can confidently recycle ePac's PE/PP mixed structures at front-of-store collections in the UK.
- Added flexibility for inclusion in local store drop-off recycling programs.

## **Recommendations for Customers:**

- Direct specific questions to OPRL and explore their calculator for recyclability considerations.
- Advocacy for monomaterial use, although mixed plastics are now recyclable.
